

EM Computation in Action

E-step

$$p^{(n)}(z=0 | w) = \frac{p(\theta_d)p^{(n)}(w | \theta_d)}{p(\theta_d)p^{(n)}(w | \theta_d) + p(\theta_B)p(w | \theta_B)}$$

M-step

$$p^{(n+1)}(w | \theta_d) = \frac{c(w, d)p^{(n)}(z=0 | w)}{\sum_{w' \in V} c(w', d)p^{(n)}(z=0 | w')}$$

Assume

$$p(\theta_d) = p(\theta_B) = 0.5$$

and $p(w | \theta_B)$ is known
