

# Typical Structure of a Research Paper (cont.)

- 4. Overview of the solution(s) (can be merged with the next part)
  - Give a high-level information description of the proposed solutions or solutions you study
  - Use examples if possible
- 5. Specific components of your solution(s)
  - Be precise (formal description helps)
  - Use intuitive descriptions to help people understand it
- Tips:
  - make sure that you organize this part so that it's understandable to people with various backgrounds
  - Don't just throw in formulas; include high-level intuitive descriptions whenever possible
