Fewer Object Types Means Easier Identification

As with speech,

- ° a smaller "vocabulary" of objects
- ° makes identification easier.

For example, one might omit

- models of lions and elephants
- from many systems.

And almost no systems need to be able

- ° to spot a rampaging Tyrannosaurus Rex,
- ° despite the fact that most humans could
- ° (or so they think).
