Eventual Consistency in Cassandra and DynamoDB

- Only one version of each data item (key-value pair)
- Last-write-wins (LWW)
 - Timestamp, typically based on *physical time*, used to determine whether to overwrite
 if(new write's timestamp > current object's timestamp) overwrite;
 else do nothing;
- With unsynchronized clocks
 - If two writes are close by in time, older write might have a newer timestamp, and might win
