Access Level Specifications Written into Class Definitions

Access to fields / functions

- is specified by
- writing a level followed by a colon
- into a class definition.

All declarations after an access specifier

- use the specified level
- (which can be changed using another specifier).

Most programmers

- organize declarations by access level
- to reduce the number of specifications.
